Winemakers Comments

This vineyard continues to astound everyone who works in it or with the fruit it provides. Year after year, it produces some of the best grapes in the state. The 2019 vintage is a testament to the expertise of our winemaking team and the quality of this site. Despite the challenges of a wet and cool growing season, the mature vines at Leorie Vineyard afforded us extended hang time, allowing the fruit to ripen more fully before harvest.

Tasting Notes

This approachable Bordeaux-style blend offers aromas of anise, red plum, and black cherry, complemented by hints of vanilla. Medium-bodied with a focused palate, this wine delivers a fruit-driven profile with soft tannins and flavors of wild bramble fruit, currants, and undertones of limestone.

Thoughts for Food

Enjoy this wine with hearty meals, braised meats such as venison, lamb, beef, or rich pasta and stews. Suggested dishes include beef wellington, pot roast, and rack of lamb.
